

Ridgefield Parks and Recreation Commission November 18, 2015 Meeting Motions

<u>Director's Report</u> <u>Recreation Center Campus</u>

After a discussion, Ms. Carey made the following motion:

"Move to approve the modification of the current Parks and Recreation Facility Use Policy that dog owners must have their dogs on a lease and under control while on the Recreation Center campus."

The Commission discussed the wording, and a decision to withdrawn the motion was made by Ms. Carey.

Ms. Dobbin made the following motion on this item:

"Move to amend the current Parks and Recreation Facility Use and Reservation Policy to reflect that the Parks and Recreation campus is included, and that on the Parks and Recreation campus, all animals must be on a leash and under the owner or walkers positive control at all times. The appropriate signage will be posted on the Recreation campus notifying public."

Motion was seconded by David Thaxter and passed unanimously.

New Business
Capital Budget Vote

Mr. Kearns presented to the Commission the proposed 2016-2017 Parks and Recreation Capital Budget. After a review Mr. Kearns made the following motion:

"Move to accept the 2016-2017 Parks and Recreation Capital Budget as put forth by the Budget Sub-Committee with the addition of a field renovator (maintenance equipment) with a cost of \$28,500, be added under Grounds Maintenance in the 2017-2018 budget."

Mr. Thaxter seconded the motion and it was unanimously passed.
