- 2. Discussion took place regarding preferred changes to the Town's native plant policy, including a list of non-invasive trees/shrubs/plantings the Buildings & Grounds Committee would like to present to the Conservation Comission for preapproval.
- 3. The list will first be vetted by the Town's tree warden, and include the specified P&R properties and reasons for any exceptions to the Town's native plant policy.

- 5. Bob Schneider shared a new request from the Ridgefield Playhouse to hold three outdoor concerts at Governor Park during summer 2023. A meeting has been scheduled to discuss with the Ridgefield Playhouse on Monday, January 30th.
