

RIDGEFIELD OUTDOOR PICKLEBALL COURT USAGE

SPRING 2024

Thank you for deferring court time to organized programs offered through Parks & Recreation this spring, when Ridgefield High School tennis courts are not available for our use.

Please take a moment to review the usage guidelines below for Spring 2024.

The following times are designated for all-inclusive play, open to any resident, member and their guest:

	Governor Park (Yanity) – 5 courts	Tues, Thurs & Sun	9am – 12pm
	Ridgefield High School (RHS)	Saturday	9am - 12pm

Notes:

- 4/8, 4/9, 4/10 (Mon-Wed), use of 3 bball courts (no tennis) after 11am.
- All Governor Park courts will be closed on Saturday, April 27 until 12pm due to Ridgefield Little League Opening Day ceremonies.
- Summer schedule expected to begin on Tuesday, June 18 and will be released on/around June 1.

Anytime outside of the designated all-inclusive play is considered available for private or closed group play on a first come, first serve basis.

- During times not designated as all-inclusive, a closed group may occupy a court for as long as you like, unless there are no other courts available and people are waiting.
- If no other courts are available and people are waiting, you may occupy the court until the top of the next hour (e.g. if it is 9:40, the top of the next hour is 10:00). This is on the honor system.
- Basketball play and tennis play is included in this on the hour rotation system during the times that are not designated as all-inclusive play. For example, if a basketball or tennis player or players arrive and pickleball is playing, basketball (or tennis) will start at the top of the next hour and run until the top of the following hour.

Closed group is defined as a group of private players that do not have to open their game to outside players.

Open play is modeled after regular indoor rules and all are welcome to rotate into the game.
